PUBLIC COMMENT

Only the three (3) Engineering Firms who were present spoke along with the other Town representatives.

Supervisor Henry noted that three (3) Engineering firms were asked to provide information/presentations concerning their respective firms. He noted that each firm is being asked to provide their firms thoughts/plans regarding engineering studies for our Town's recent notice of obtaining up to a \$30,000 Engineering Planning Grant for our Sewer System Evaluation project. Supervisor Henry said each firm is being provided with one hour time allocations to make their presentations.

The first firm was AES represented by Jim Dougan and Todd Hodgson.

The second firm was Bernier, Carr & Associates represented by Mick Leham and Matt Cooper.

The third firm was Laberge Group represented by Steve Adams and Ben Snyder.

Discussion concerning the following was held:

The Town's requirement to provided 'matching funds or in-kind services" up to \$7500.00 depending on the total amount of the grant.

Income survey – do an income survey of sewer district customers which may be a way of obtaining additional grants.

Sewer Plant reed beds – the need to remove old sledge and disposal/cost of doing so.

Generators for pump stations – included in this discussion was the possibility of obtaining grants for funding of new generators in the future.

The Laberge Group was the last to complete their presentation which ended at 7:27 PM.

The Town Board discussed the pros and cons of each firms' presentation. It was the consensus of the Board at the end of their lengthy discussion that clarification was needed from all three (3) firms concerning the Town's requirement to match 25% of the total grant once approved.

Supervisor Henry asked Councilor Willie Giroux if he would meet with him to make phone contact with the three firms. Councilor Giroux agreed to do so. Supervisor Henry said he would contact Councilor Giroux to set-up a time.

The Town Board discussed a residents request for reimbursement of a \$1,405.80 Water Bill.

Town Supervisor Mark Henry asked for a motion to adjourn.
